# Open Call for Consultants

to be listed in a resource provided to private developers pursuant to the  
One-Percent for Public Art on Private Projects Ordinance

## **Prospectus:**

On June 28, 2016, Berkeley City Council adopted the One-Percent for Public Art on Private Projects Ordinance, which requires developers of private projects to devote one percent of the construction cost to publicly accessible art in the proposed development, or instead pay a reduced fee to an in lieu fund. To follow the requirements for the production of public art on-site, developers must engage the services of a public art consultant from an approved list. The Civic Arts Office is currently accepting qualifications from professional public art consultants to be considered for this list.

## **Eligibility:**

Open to all professional public art consultants working in Northern California. A qualified public art consultant may be a curator, designer or art consultant with proven experience of overseeing artist selection and management of art in public places.
